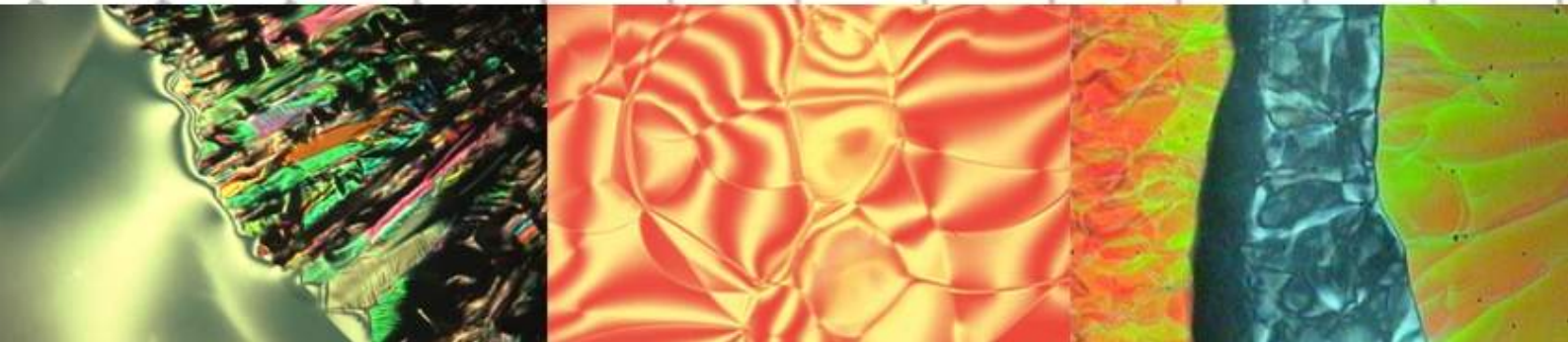
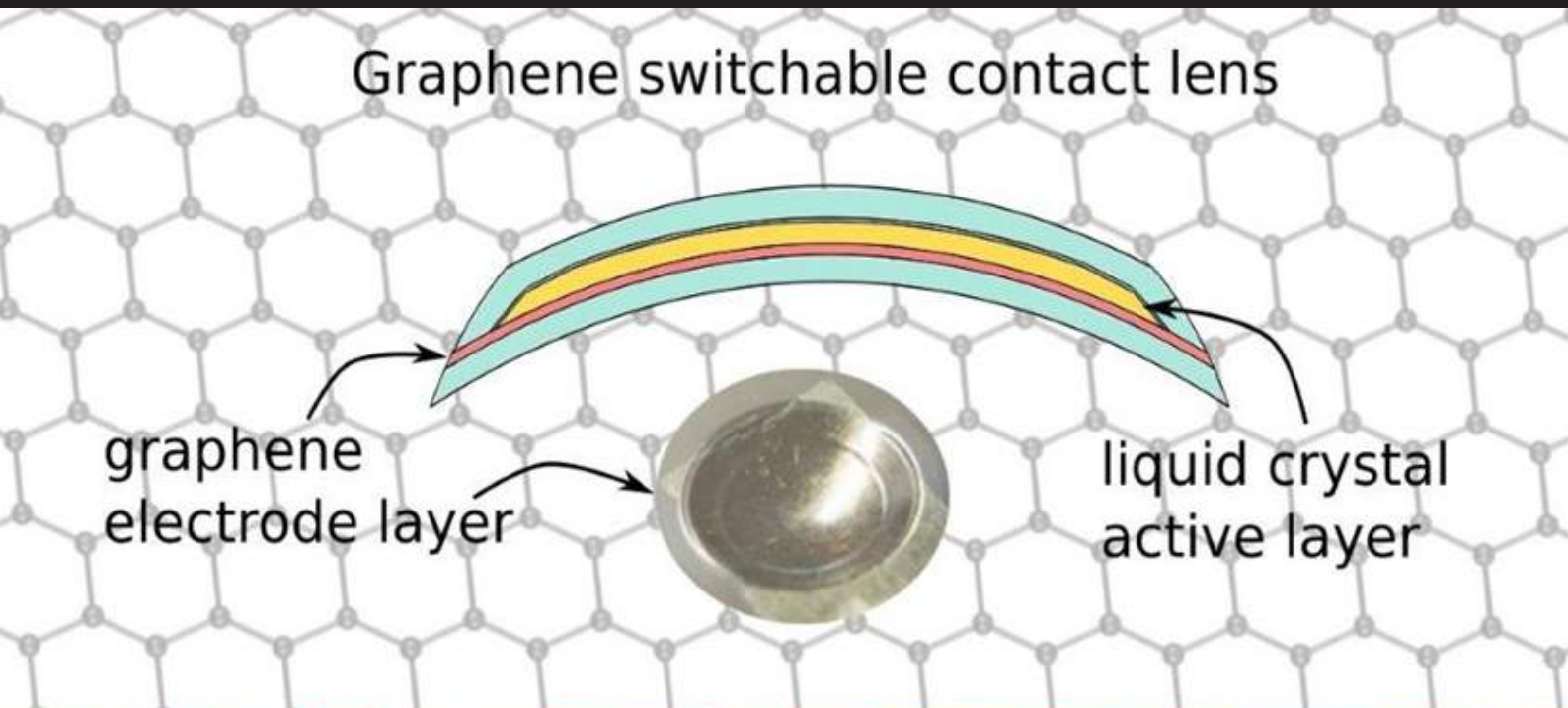


Looking Through A Liquid Crystal Ball
